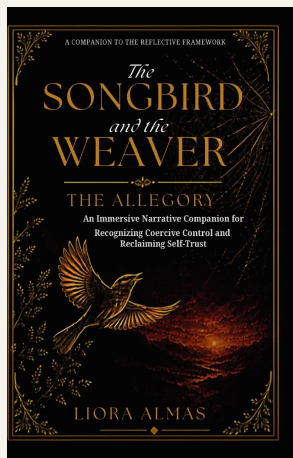
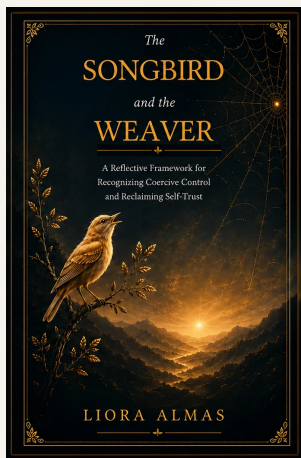


The Songbird and the Weaver
